85/2020 **PLANNING**

**Planning Applications received since 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020 or any other planning issues**

Cllr Mrs G Tomlins left the remote meeting and abstained from any discussion or voting on the below application.

- (a) 20/02235/FUL- Erection of a garden room following removal of a conservatory including internal alterations at Willow House, Nobold, Baschurch, Shrewsbury, Shropshire.

*Cllr Mrs S Richards outlined the application and after some discussion she proposed to support the application. This was seconded by Cllr T Feltus and passed with two abstentions. Shropshire Council to be informed.*

- (b) 20/02249/FUL- Erection of two storey side extension at Rossendale, Yeaton. Baschurch, Shrewsbury, Shropshire.

*Cllr Mrs S Richards outlined the application and after some discussion she proposed to support the application. This was seconded by Cllr Mrs G Tomlins and passed with one abstention. Shropshire Council to be informed.*

**Planning Permission Granted**

- 20/01703/FUL - Erection of a storage container and installation of 998Kw ground source heat pump at Fenemere Manor, Myddlewood, Nr Baschurch, Shrewsbury, Shropshire.

**Planning Application Withdrawn**

- 19/05266/FUL- Erection of two dwellings (One open market dwelling and one affordable dwelling) formation of car park for Weston Lullingfields Primary School; provision of wildlife area to include wildlife pond, wild flower meadow and woodland areas; and improvements to bus turning on road frontage at Land east of War Memorial Weston Lullingfields, Baschurch, Shrewsbury, Shropshire.

**86/2020 SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL REPORT**

Cllr N Bardsley reported that the Expression of Interest submitted by Baschurch Parish Council for safety railings to protect pedestrians to be sited in Eyton Lane, Baschurch had been considered by the Internal Infrastructure Group and it had been agreed that the CIL Local Fund would fund the work up to an amount of £30,000.00 and the Parish Council would cover the additional costs. This was to be discussed further with Shropshire Council.

**88/2020 RIGHTS OF WAY/PUBLIC FOOTPATHS**

Cllr Mrs G Tomlins reported that the footpath signs had not been re-instated at the junction with Barclay Street and James Way and Barclay Street to the Church.

**89/2020 TO ADOPT THE ANNUAL GOVERNANCE STATEMENT OF BASCHURCH PARISH COUNCIL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2020.**

The Clerk submitted the accounts for Baschurch Parish Council for the year ending 31st March 2020. The Annual Governance Statement of Assurance had been fully explained by the Clerk previously and was agreed and proposed by Cllr B Leeden and seconded by Cllr Mrs G Tomlins and passed by all present. The Chairman and Clerk to sign the Annual Governance Statement of Assurance.

**90/2020 TO ADOPT THE AUDITED STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS AND BALANCE SHEET FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2020.**

The Clerk submitted the statement of accounts and balance sheet for the year ending 31st March 2020. The adoption of the Accounts was agreed and proposed by Cllr T Feltus and seconded by Cllr B Leeden and passed by all present. The Chairman and Clerk to both sign the Annual Return

Other items of expenditure for consideration

- (a) To fix a date for the next Finance & General Purposes Committee meeting.  
The Clerk would look into setting the time and date remotely.
- (b) Baschurch Cemetery- Bench.

It had recently been found that a bench in the Cemetery would need replacing before the winter. Cllr Mrs S Richards had looked into pricings for the bench and told Councillors that she felt the bench would look more in keeping if it were the same as the two new recently purchased benches. She opened the discussion on this but stated she would abstain from voting on the decision. After some discussion it was proposed by Cllr T Feltus and seconded by Cllr Mrs G Tomlins to order the same style bench as was now in situ. This was passed with two abstentions. The cost of the bench would be approx. £785.00 plus VAT. This would be funded from the Neighbourhood Fund.

92/2020 VACANCIES FOR PARISH COUNCILLORS

Cllr Mrs S Richards informed Councillors that there had been a number of applicants and a separate meeting would be held to discuss the co-options in July.

93/2020 CORRESPONDENCE

Litter Bins/Dog Bins in the Village The Clerk stated she had received complaints from local residents that the dog bin on the Playground at Badgers Way and the dog bin in Nobold were often full and overflowing. The Clerk had contacted Shropshire Council to empty both bins as they were their responsibility although the Parish Council had agreed to put a larger bin in the Badgers Way Playground as the bin was too small for the litter that was being deposited in it.
